The Tories are back in office and they are on the rampage. We have to organise to stop them.

Why you should join the demonstration:

1 This government plan to cut £12bn from welfare hitting the most vulnerable in our society hardest.

2 The richest 1,000 people in Britain doubled their wealth during the last parliament, while the living standards of the majority fell.

3 There has been a huge rise in zero hour contracts, precarious, low-paid and part-time work. Millions of people are not benefiting from the supposed economic 'recovery'.

4 The Tories have presided over the worst housing crisis in living memory. They are the friends of private landlords and property - developers. Now they want to sell off even more social' housing.

5 The Tories are pushing privatisation. They want to encourage international free trade deals which will destroy the public sector.

6 Our NHS is under attack. The government plans to dismantle the NHS and sell it off to private companies to run for profit.

7 Education is being savaged. The Tories are threatening to raise university fees even higher. Academies and free schools are taking over denying any democratic control over our children's education.

8 Migrants are facing a racist backlash. They are being scapegoated for the problems caused by the bankers and bosses.
